Form Descriptions

This packet includes a variety of materials that are required by each student participant in the FIRST Competition. The following is a description of each form found in the packet. Other forms may become necessary as the activity progresses.

- 1) Letter to Parent or Guardian
This letter briefly describes the program in which your son/daughter has chosen to participate.
(This letter does not have to be returned)
- 2) Student Contract
Commitment by students and parents/guardians to follow the rules and guidelines as presented in the Team Voltage Handbook.
(All participants must fill out this form on-line (preferred) or return this form.)
- 3) Student Application
Application requesting membership on Team Voltage and providing initial review information for the membership selection process.
(All participants must fill out this form on-line (preferred) or return this form.)
- 4) Photograph/Film Release/Permission Form
The school, the School Board of Brevard County and FIRST require this form. It allows the student's photo to be used in media relations, our team web site, and other school/team resources as identified on the form. This form requests a parent/guardian signature to authorize your child to participate in the program and its activities.
(All participants must return this form.)
- 5) Medical Release Form
This form is required by the school and the School Board of Brevard County. It verifies that parent/guardian permission is granted for your child to be treated if injured during team activities. An original, notarized, multi-part form must be provided to the team facilitator.
(All participants must return this form.)

Additional Off-Campus Student Activities Forms will be distributed throughout the season when actual dates for the events are known. The school and the School Board of Brevard County require these forms. They verify that parent/guardian permission is granted for your child to participate in off-campus activities. They intend to explain that students will need to arrange their own transportation to and from some program activities.
